The CPCA Safety and Health Committee is now accepting applications for the CPCA Safety Awards. Awards are available in two categories based on 2015 statistics:

- **Workplace Safety** - based upon size of the plant and the number of "lost time" injuries during the calendar year.
- **Driving Safety** - based upon the number of power units (including passenger and light trucks) and the number of at-fault accidents during the calendar year.

All producer members of CPCA are eligible for the awards. Separate awards may be given in each category to each dues-paying plant. Specific qualifications are explained on the enclosed application and award details.

Deadline for submitting applications is **Monday, April 17, 2017**. Awards will be presented during the Spring Conference May 2, 2017 at the Crown Plaza in Ventura Beach. You do not need to be present to receive your award, but we hope you will be.

SAFETY AWARDS PROGRAM

Purpose: To promote safe working conditions and to encourage reduced incidents of injuries and accidents by our member companies.

Method: To award member plants having exemplary safety records with certificates which acknowledge their excellent results in:

Workplace Safety

Separate **Workplace Safety** awards will be issued in each of two categories, with criteria for plants as follows:

- Under 25 employees, an award if:

No Lost Time Injuries

- 25 or more employees, an award if:

**1 Injury with 5 or Less Days
of Lost Time**

("Lost time" means more than 8 hours missed work after the day of injury.)

Driving Safety

Driving Safety awards will acknowledge driving excellence as evidenced by lack of "at-fault" accidents, and be awarded as follows:

- Plants with 10 or less Power Units:

No At-Fault Accidents

- Plants with 11 or more Power Units:

No More than One At-Fault Accident

("At-Fault" is ANY accident that is even only partially the fault of the driver.)

Awards: Certificates will be presented annually at the Spring CPCA meeting, and will be based upon prior calendar-year results. Awards will be provided to each plant and/or each location that are members of CPCA, based upon written applications.

Note: All award winners receive certificates for placement in plaques. Plaques are provided first year of winning an award only.

Eligibility: Producer members award eligibility will be determined by the Safety Committee, subject to approval by the Board of Directors.
